- I. **PURPOSE:** To minimize the spread of infection by food workers.
- II. **POLICY:** Corrections Medicine staff provides the required vaccinations and guidelines to incarcerated food service workers to prevent the spread of infection to the incarcerated population.
- III. **RESPONSIBILITY:** All staff members in the Corrections Medicine program shall be familiar with the content of this policy and the procedure therein.
- IV. **PROCEDURE:**
 - 1. All incarcerated worker working in food service must be free from skin infections and other illnesses that are transmittable by food or utensils.
 - 2. All incarcerated kitchen workers and all employees working in the kitchen shall receive their first Hepatitis A vaccine injection in the series.
 - 3. All incarcerated kitchen workers shall have a tuberculosis (TB) skin test completed and be determined to be free of TB prior to being assigned to kitchen duty.
